Northampton Girl Gets Commission In Army Nurse Corps

Jeanne Seltzer, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harry E. Seltzer, 1537 Washington Avenue, Northampton, will leave today to begin her Army career at Camp Lee, Va., after receiving a commission as second lieutenant in the U. S. Army Nurses Corps.

Lieut. Seltzer will receive four weeks of basic training at Camp Lee, after which she will be transferred to Fort Story, Va., for an indefinite time.

She is a graduate of Northampton High school, class of 1940, and St. Luke's Hospital School for Nurses, class of 1943. She began her nursing activities in the Haff hospital, Northampton where she was employed for six months. She then entered Poly-Clinic hospital, New York city, to take up post-graduate work. While there she was assistant supervisor of obstetrics for four months. Previous to enlisting in the Army Nurses Corps, she did general duty work at St. Luke's hospital for the past four weeks.
