Former Nazareth Dentist On Duty At Air Base

A former Nazareth dentist, Dr. Reuben I. Brazina, is now treating one of his patients in civilian life, Arthur Theodore, of Allentown, at a Far East Air Service Command base where both are stationed with a unit recently cited by President Roosevelt for meritorious service in the repair and maintenance of combat and transport aircraft.

Dr. Brazina, now a captain, is the husband of the former Evelyn Getz, who with their daughter, Marcia Leah, reside at 827 North Sixth Street, Allentown.

He entered service in February, 1943, and after a short period at Columbia Air Base was sent overseas. He became chief dental surgeon for the Air Forces in the jungles of the South Pacific. Under the most adverse conditions he established a model dental clinic with salvage and improvised equipment.

Sergeant Theodore is a son of Mrs. Ida Theodore, of 231 Liberty Street, Allentown. He entered service in May, 1942, and had been employed at the Bethlehem Steel Company.
