Word has been received that Capt. Charles A. Van Billiard, formerly of this city, has been appointed commanding officer of Company B, 7th Training Battalion, at Camp Wheeler, Ga.

Capt. Van Billiard, who is a son of the late John T. Van Billiard and a brother of M. W. Van Billiard, 1312 West North Street, has served in the regular army for approximately two and a half years.

Formerly employed at the Laros Textiles Company, he was called into the service as a first lieutenant and assigned to the Army Induction office at Wilkes-Barre. While there he received his captaincy and was appointed second in command of the induction center.

In May of this year he was sent to Fort Benning, Ga., for specialized field training and later was assigned to Camp Wheeler for special duty.
