### Local Machinist's Mate Now Out of Hospital

Anthony Andraschko, machinist's mate 3/C, son of Mrs. Theresa Andraschko, 945 Wyandotte Street, who served three years and three months in the service, 26 months of which were on active duty overseas, was recently discharged at the Philadelphia Naval Hospital.

While supporting landings at Ormak Bay, Andraschko received shrapnel wounds in both legs and his right arm, when a suicide plane hit his ship. NOV 12 1945

MIM3/C Andraschko received his boot training at Newport, R. I., and attended Great Lakes Naval School for four months. He wears the Pacific Theater ribbon with three battle stars, American Defense ribbon, Philippine campaign ribbon and the Purple Heart. Before entering the service, the ex-sailor was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
