Local Soldier With Ski Troops

Pfc. Andrew P. Nicholson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley F. Nicholson, 112 West Market Street, will round up one year of service in the United States Army Jan. 28.

Pfc. Nicholson received his basic training at Camp Robinson, Ark. He was later transferred to Fort Meade, Md., and thence to A. P. Hill Military Reservation, where he was currently on maneuvers. While at Fort Meade, he received the experts medal for discharging the 60mm mortar hand grenade and for the use of the bayonet. Also, the sharpshooter's medal in light machine-gun, carbine, M1 rifle and pistol.

At present he is stationed at Camp McCoy, attached to the 417th Infantry. His company is undergoing winterized training in the way of skiing, using snowshoes, etc. Nicholson will observe his twenty-second birthday anniversary Feb. 12. He has a brother, Stanley Jr., stationed with the Signal Corps outfit at Camp Crowder, Mo.
