## Lieut. Cohen, Easton, Officer On Lost Ship

Aboard the transport McCawley when it sailed to the South Pacific a short time ago was Lieut. (j.g.) H. I. Cohen, Easton. It is believed by relatives here that he may not have been aboard the transport when it was sunk by Japanese submarine attack, after being pounded by Japanese air power, in the landing of American

forces on Rendova Island, three days ago. News dispatches indicate there was no loss of American lives in the sinking of the transport. The lieutenant's wife is a counselor at Camp Pinemere, near Bartonsville. Her Easton address is 682 Bushkill Street. She is fearful of her husband's safety and is anxiously awaiting official word of his fate.
