Lieutenant's Commission Given C. E. Siebecker

Carl E. Siebecker, 22, of 30 West Market Street, Bethlehem, graduated from Officers' Training School at Fort Belvoir, Va., with a second lieutenant's commission in the Army, according to word received here yesterday by Bethlehem U. S. Selective Service Board No. 2, with headquarters in the Bethlehem Trust Building, from which he entered the service.

Lieut. Siebecker, whose commission is with the engineers' corps, has been transferred to an engineers' detachment somewhere in California. He was an accelerated senior in the business administration course at Lehigh University when he withdrew in September of last year.

Before entering the Army as a volunteer officer candidate the day after Christmas last year, Lieut. Siebecker was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

A native of Bethlehem, he was graduated in 1940 from Liberty High School where he was a member of the swimming team, was a member of the year book staff and active in Hi-Y work.
