Cited for Bravery

AN EIGHTH AAF FIGHTER STATION, England. — Second Lt. Edward M. Nebinger, 1114 West North Street, Bethlehem, Pa., has been awarded the Air Medal in an announcement made by the Headquarters of Major General William E. Kepner, Commanding General of the Eighth Fighter Command.

The citation for the flier, a member of the P-47 Thunderbolt Fighter Group commanded by Lt. Col. Philip E. Tukey, Jr., of Cape Elizabeth, Me., read as follows: "For meritorious service in aerial flight over enemy occupied Continental Europe. The courage, coolness, and skill displayed by the pilot reflects credit upon himself and the Armed Forces of the United States."
