Pfc. Donald C. Braxmeyer, Fifth Air Force, is observing his 21st birthday anniversary today somewhere in New Guinea. Pfc. Braxmeyer was inducted into the service on February 19, 1943, and received his basic training at Jefferson Barracks, Mo. He was graduated from the Army Administration School at Jonesboro, Ark., and was stationed at Barnes Field, Westfield, Mass.; Green Field, Providence, R. I., and Hillsgrove Airport, Providence, before being sent overseas. He arrived in Australia in December and was later transferred to New Guinea.

Pfc. Braxmeyer is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Aloysius Braxmeyer, 263 West Laurel Street, and is a member of the class of 1943 at Bethlehem Technical High School. He has a brother in the service, Cpl. Robert A. Braxmeyer, who is in the Air Corps at Delhart, Texas.
