**Former Local Man
Meets Sailor Brother
Serving on Okinawa**

Word has been received by Mrs. Ottomar Schramm, Gray Cottage, Nazareth, that her brother, MAM2/C, Willard N. Edelman, formerly of 216 West Elizabeth Avenue, this city, recently met his brother, S1/C Charles C. Edelman, on Okinawa. It was the first time in three years that the brothers had met. MAM2/C Edelman also informed his sister that he had recently been promoted to his present rank. He has served with the Navy for nearly four years in the European and Pacific theaters, while S1/C Charles Edelman has served in the Navy for almost three years, also in the European and Pacific theaters. Both brothers have seen considerable action in the Pacific and both have taken part in the invasion of Okinawa.

MAM2/C Willard Edelman and S1/C Charles Edelman are the sons of Charles Edelman of the Elizabeth Avenue address, and the late Mrs. Edelman. Previous to their enlistment in the Navy, both boys attended Liberty High School.
