## Father of Three Reported Battle Victim

Carson Kuster, 27-year-old husband of the former Anna Bellis, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Bellis, of 309 Babbitt Avenue, Pen Argyl, and only son of Mrs. Carl Reed, of 1228 Turner Street, Allentown, was killed in action in Belgium as of January 13, according

to a telegram received by Mrs. Reed and relayed to the Bellis family in Pen Argyl. Kuster has been listed as "missing in action since January 5, in Belgium," according to a telegram received the previous day by his mother.

He entered service in June, 1944, and went overseas in December with an infantry unit. Prior to induction he was employed by the Consolidated-Vultee Aircraft Company at Allentown.

In addition to his wife and mother, he is survived by a grandmother and three sons, Kenneth, Richard and Stanley.
