Local G. I. On Furlough At Philippine Resort

S/Sgt. Joseph F. Chiz, 1807 East Fourth St., recently spent an eleven-day furlough in Baguio, Luzon, Summer capital and playground of the Philippines, as a guest of Camp John Hay's recreation center.

Sgt. Chiz entered the Army December, 1943, from his home here, where his wife, Mrs. Margaret Chiz, now resides. His father, John Chiz, lives at 428 Hayes St. After training at Camp Gordon, Ga., Sgt. Chiz embarked February 10, 1945, for overseas duty in France, England, Belgium, Holland, Germany and the Philippines.

He has been awarded the European Theatre Ribbon, the Asiatic-Pacific Ribbon with one battle star, the Philippine Liberation Ribbon with one battle star and the Good Conduct Medal. Sgt. Chiz is now serving as mess sergeant with the 795th Military Police Battalion on Luzon.
