**Sgt. William Marshall  
Scheduled <sup>AUG</sup> To 3 Dock <sup>1945</sup>  
After Overseas Duty**

Sgt. William M. Marshall II, husband of the former Ruth Weidner, Wydnor, is scheduled to dock at Hampton Roads, Va., Saturday, aboard the "Fairfax." He is a veteran of 13 months overseas' duty in North Africa, Sicily and Italy. Wearer of the Good Conduct Medal and several combat stars, he will spend a 30-day furlough with his wife visiting his parents, Major and Mrs. William M. Marshall, East Northfield, Mass., and several weeks at a Summer resort on the shores of Massachusetts.

Sgt. Marshall enlisted in the Ski Troops and trained at Camp Hale, Colo., and later was transferred to Fort Benning, Ga. He was assigned to the 100th Division at Camp Forrest, Tenn., and trained further at Fort Bragg, N. C., and Fort Meade, Md., going overseas in June, 1944. The sergeant is scheduled to return to Fort Devens, Mass., for further assignment.
