Dr. Joseph N. Corriere, one of Bethlehem's well-known younger doctors, has been advanced to the rank of captain, according to word received today from headquarters of the Army Medical Corps at Northington General Hospital, Tuscaloosa, Ala.

Captain Corriere served as chief urologist at the Easton hospital and at St. Luke's before entering the Army Medical Corps August 17, 1943. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. B. Corriere of 667 Ferry Street, East ton, and is a graduate of Easton High School and Lafayette College. His M. D. degree was received at Loyola University, Chicago and his graduate degree in urology at the Graduate School of Médicine, University of Pennsylvania. Following his graduation, he served as an instructor in urology at the graduate school of the University of Pennsylvania.
