Bangor Soldier Killed; Roseto Man Wounded

According to a second telegram received on Saturday afternoon by Mrs. Esther Stahl of Meyers Crossing, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Jennings, her husband, Pfc. Floyd Stahl of the United States Army, is now reported as killed in action in France as of July 5.

On July 30 Mrs. Stahl received a telegram from the War Department that her husband was reported missing in action. Her last letter from him was dated in France as of July 3.

Mrs. Mary Filingo, of Garibaldi Street, Roseto, received word recently that her husband, Pvt. Stephen Filingo, of the United States Army, was slightly wounded in action in France. No further word of his condition has been received.

He was inducted into the armed forces in September, 1943, and received his basic training at Camp Van Dorn, Miss. He was sent overseas in February, 1943.
