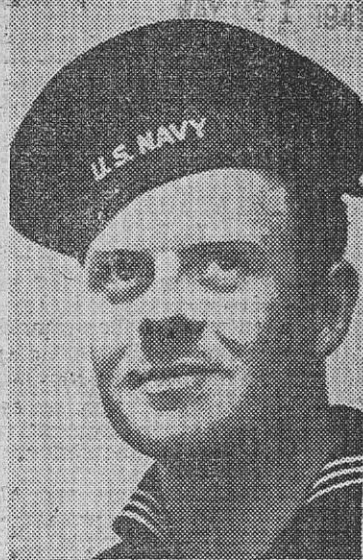


Deutsch Jr., Frank

Leroy J. Dimmick, with the 111th U. S. N. B. C. in the Philippines, has been promoted from Seaman 1/C to Coxswain. He enlisted in the Seabees July, 1943, and completed his training at Camp Endicott, R. I., before going overseas to England. He participated in the D-Day amphibious operations and was returned to England. Coxswain Dimmick returned to the States aboard a troop ship carrying 1500 German prisoners, where he served as a guard. Upon completing a short leave, he returned to the Camp Endicott Redistribution Center and was assigned to the Pacific area. Prior to enlisting, he was employed by the Bethlehem Fabricators.
