Reported Wounded** AUG 20 1943

Mr. and Mrs. Claude Andrews Sr., Walnutport Route 2, have been notified by the War Department that their son, Corporal Claude Andrews Jr., was wounded in action July 12. Just how seriously he was wounded was not revealed.

Andrews, who graduated from Slatington High School in 1940, has been in North Africa since the opening of the second front there and took part in the campaign.

In a letter to his parents after the initial African fight, Andrews wrote that he had had some experiences. It is not known whether he participated in the Sicilian campaign.
