Mrs. Catherine Rengel, 721 East Sixth Street, received a War Department telegram yesterday, informing her that her son, Staff Sergeant Joseph J. Rengel, was wounded in action in France December 3.

Inducted February 3, 1942, Sgt. Rengel was sent overseas in August, 1944. He was recently promoted to Staff Sergeant for excellent qualities of leadership and outstanding performance of duty.

Two brothers are serving overseas, John Rengel, in England, and Julius Rengel in Burma.

Before entering the service, Sgt. Rengel was employed by the Philadelphia, Bethlehem, and New England Railroad Company.
