Edward Chadny, 1009 Jeter Avenue, has been promoted from private first class to corporal in his artillery battalion serving with the 40th Infantry on the island of New Britain.

Cpl. Chadny, son of Mr. and Mrs. Alex Chadny, was inducted into the Army September 2, 1943, and received his basic training at Fort McClellan, Ala. He went overseas in March, 1944, and after spending a few months in the Hawaiian Islands he was shipped to the South Pacific. For the past eight months he has helped to make escape-proof the trap which now surrounds the remaining Japs at Rabaul, New Britain.
