Sergeant Harold E. Bussard, whose engagement to Miss Mary Ozimek, 610 Leibert Street, was announced in October 1942, was killed in action on France June 18, according to a communication from the War Department received by his relatives in Hagerstown, Md. Sgt. Bussard was stationed in Bethlehem at the Floyd Simons Armory for several months prior to his departure overseas in October, 1942. He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Christopher Bussard; two brothers, Lieut. William Bussard and Pvt. Howard Bussard, all of Hagerstown, Md.
