Inducted June 25, 1942, he completed his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and Fort Meade, Md., before shipping overseas. Lt. Deschler served 22 months in Dutch Guinea. Arriving back in the States Jan. 24, 1945, he was commissioned a second lieutenant at Fort Benning, Ga.
