**Lt. Louis C. Cuchran  
Discharged After  
41 Months of Service**

Following 41 months duty in the U. S. Army during which time he accumulated 83 discharge points while serving with the Fifth and Seventh Armies in four major European battles, Lt. Louis C. Cuchran,

531 Selfridge Street, was released to inactive duty at Indiantown Gap Tuesday.

A veteran of two major battles in Italy, the invasion of southern France, and the battle of Germany, Lt. Cuchran returned to the States last June and was interned at Camp Edwards Convalescent Hospital before being sent to Indiantown Gap for separation.

Lt. Cuchran graduated from Bethlehem Catholic High School with the class of '31 and received his B. A. degree at Muhlenberg College in 1935.
