## Comdr. Fisher On Leave from Active Duty

Commander and Mrs. Luther I. Fisher arrived in Bethlehem last evening following a brief visit with relatives in Gettysburg. Commander Fisher arrived in San Francisco, February 15, after one and a half years overseas duty.

Commander Fisher, a well known Bethlehem physician, is on leave from his position as Chief of Medical Service in St. Luke's Hospital. He left Bethlehem in December 1941, was in this country with the U. S. Navy Medical Reserve until August 1942 when he shipped for overseas duty.

Commander Fisher has been stationed in the South Pacific area, having seen action with the Third Marine Corps in the Bougainville area in November 1943, where his hospital unit was located in the combat zone. His experience includes service in the Solomon Islands.
