awarded the Bronze Star "for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy on Leyte, Philippines, November 12, 1944." The citation accompanying the award read, "At approximately 1140, an enemy plane bombed and crash-dived a ship, inflicting many casualties. T/5 Choke voluntarily accompanied aid men and a medical officer to the ship in a effort to be of assistance. He returned to the shore and brought needed medical supplies back to the strickical supplies back to the strick-en vessel. At this time he as-sisted in the treatment of casualties and his cooperation and ualties and his cooperation and help were instrumental in the effective results obtained. These actions took place during an air alert. Following this, Choke was of great value in evacuating the casualties.
