Given Oak Leaf  
Cluster For Service**

AN EIGHTH AIR FORCE  
BOMBER STATION, England—Sergeant James P. Morganello, 21-year-old ball turret gunner on an Eighth Air Force B-17 Flying Fortress, has been presented the first Oak Leaf Cluster to the Air Medal for "meritorious achievement" during bombing attacks on Nazi military and industrial targets and in support of Allied ground forces. The award was presented by Col. Charles B. Dougher of Wilkes-Barre, Pa., commanding officer of the 94th Bomb. Group.

Sgt. Morganello is the son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Morganello, 517 Atlantic Street, Bethlehem. He was a machinist before enlisting in the Army Air Forces.
