tablished a brilliant record as a spearhead unit in the drive to free Europe from Nazi rule, and has volunteered for Pacific duty.

Now at Camp St. Louis, France, Pfc. Oskin is undergoing processing for redeployment and will receive 30-day furlough before transferring to the Pacific. His decorations include the Good Conduct Medal, Combat Infantry Badge and the ETO ribbon with two battle stars.
