**Coplay Soldier
Killed in Plane Crash 1943**

Pvt. First Class Albert F. Boger, 23, son of I. J. Frey, of Northampton, died July 29 as the result of an airplane accident in the Pacific area. Circumstances surrounding the accident are not known.

Private Boger was born in Buffalo, N. Y., on May 9, 1920, the son of Ivin J. and the late Carrie nee Ramer Frey. Following the death of his mother, he was adopted at an early age by the late James and Ida Boger of Germansville R. 1. He attended the Heidelberg township School and was employed by C. E. Imsweiler of Colmar, prior to entering the service in November of 1941. A member of the Infantry, Pvt. Boger was sent overseas in July of 1942.

Survived by his father and a sister, Mrs. George Stein, of Coplay R. D. 1, he was engaged to Mary Ellen Bishop of Lansdale.
