## John H. Weikel Dies In Battle Of Germany

Having been seriously wounded in Germany November 23, Mr. and Mrs. C. H. H. Weikel, of Saucon Valley Road, were notified by the War Department last evening, that their son, Private First Class John Hart Weikel died from the wounds December 3.

The Weikel's received a telegram on Pearl Harbor Day, Dec. 7, stating that their son was seriously wounded in Germany.

Private First Class Weikel was graduated from the Episcopal High School, Alexandria, Va., June of 1943, and shortly after his graduation entered the Army. Placed in the Infantry, he trained at Camp Fannin, Texas, and Camp Maxey, Texas, before being shipped overseas.

He is survived by his parents, and one sister, Harriet, the wife of William Paige Hitchcock.

December 28, 1944
