Pfc. Russell Bauer Receives Second Wound in Action

Mr. and Mrs. Roland Bauer, 640 Ontario Street, have received a telegram from the War Department announcing that their son, Pfc. Russell Bauer has been seriously wounded in action somewhere in Italy. This was the second time he was wounded in action.

On January 31, a few days after taking part in the invasion of the Anzio sector where a beachhead was established, Pfc. Bauer was wounded and later received the Purple Heart. After recovering he returned to active duty in March.

Early in May, according to word received by his parents, he received the Expert Combat Infantry Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. The date of the second wounding was May 24, the War Department stated.

Before entering the service February 25, 1943, he was employed in the office of the Bethlehem Steel. He was a graduate of Bethlehem High Second, class of 1941, and is a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church.
