**Pvt. L. Snyder,
Nazareth, Reported
Slightly Wounded**

Pvt. Leonard M. Snyder, 34, husband of the former Beatrice E. Genseleiter, of 959 North Street, Allentown, and son of William Snyder, Sr., South Broad Street, Nazareth, was slightly wounded in action in Germany December 19. He was sent to a hospital in Paris and later was evacuated to England.

Mrs. Snyder received a letter from him written in the hospital Christmas Eve, in which he says that the only thing that worries him is that his Christmas presents may not catch up with him.

Pvt. Snyder, father of two children, entered the service last March and received training at Camp Blanding, Fla., and was sent overseas in September. He has seen action in France and Germany.

Prior to entering the service, Pvt. Snyder was graduated from Nazareth High School and attended Muhlenberg College for two years. He was employed by Mack Manufacturing Corporation, Allentown.
