Rev. Stevenson Promoted to Captaincy

The Rev. Dean T. Stevenson, formerly assistant pastor of the Pro-Cathedral Church of the Nativity, who resigned his post to become a chaplain in the Army, has been promoted to the rank of captain.

Captain Stevenson is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Stevenson, 554 East Arch Street, Pottsville. He entered World War II on June 1, 1942 and was sent to Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana.

He was made a first lieutenant and sent to Camp White, Oregon, July 15, 1942. He had received a second lieutenantcy upon graduating from Lehigh University R. O. T. C. in 1937.
