Local G-I Witness To Mussolini's End

Pfc. Lawrence Bringenberg, an infantryman with the Fifth Army in Italy, wrote his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Bringenberg, 453 Montclair Avenue, of how he witnessed the killing of Mussolini, his mistress and henchmen, and the mob reaction which followed.

Stationed overseas for the past two years, Pfc. Bringenberg needs one point to return to his wife, Tessie, and their three year old daughter, Gail at 903 East Fourth Street. He entered the service over two years ago, while employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. He is a graduate of Bethlehem Catholic High School and studied art in New York City. These brothers also serving are Thomas, F 1/c USN, stationed in the Pacific; Pfc. Paul, now in China, and Leonard, Coxswain 2/c USN, stationed in Austria.
