Men From Area Wounded In Action

According to word received from the War Department, a Bethlehem and an Allentown soldier have been wounded in action. The boys are Pvt. Wilbur L. Young and Pvt. Robert Fenstermaker.

Young is the son of Mrs. Lotte H. Young of 578 Benner Avenue, this city. He is an aviation mechanic in the Army Air Forces and was wounded in the European area. He was inducted into the service on June 12, 1942, and received his training at Fort Meade, Camp Kilmer and Seymour-Johnson Field, N. C.

The Allentown soldier is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward P. Fenstermaker of 247 East Susquehanna Street, Allentown. He was wounded in action in France on June 22 and has been removed to a hospital in England for treatment, according to a letter received by his parents. Fenstermaker entered the service on June 30, 1943, and received his training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., having been overseas since January.
