


Rupert, Clinton A.

Pfc. Clinton A. Rupert, 18, who has recently been graduated from the gunnery school at Tyndall Air Field, Fla., and received his Silver Wings as a gunner, is spending some time with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Idus Rupert, 100 East High Street, Nazareth, before reporting to Westover Air Field, Mass., for further training.

Pfc. Rupert received C. A. P. training at the Easton Armory from December 31, 1943, until May 12 1944. He was then sent to Keesler Field for basic and advanced training in the U. S. Army Air Corps. He attended gunnery school at Tyndall Air Field, Fla., from which place he was graduated, receiving his Silver Wings and also a promotion to private first class.

Before entering the service he attended Nazareth High School.

October 6, 1944
