**Pfc. Louis S. Maco  
Wounded On Okinawa**

Pfc. Louis S. Maco, who was wounded June 19, 1945, while in action with the 2nd Marine Division on Okinawa, is convalescing at a U. S. Naval Hospital in Oceanside, Calif.

Veteran of the Saipan, Guam and Tinian campaigns, Pfc. Maco has been serving overseas since May, 1944. He enlisted September 1943 at the age of 17 and received his training at Parris Island, S. C. and at Camp Lejeune, N. C. A son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Maco, the young Marine is a graduate of Bethlehem Catholic High School.

Two of his brothers were recently discharged. John J., 512 Second Avenue, who was discharged from the Royal Canadian Air Force and Paul, 602 Norway Place who was discharged in December after 2½ years of service in the U. S. Army.
