**Sgt. J. J. Kiss
To Be Speaker
At Union Session**

A regular monthly meeting of Local 2600, USA-CIO will be held this evening at 8 o'clock in union headquarters, 218 East Third Street.

Staff Sergeant Joseph J. Kiss, a former Bethlehem Steel worker and member of Local 2600, recently returned from the European war theatre will be the principal speaker, talking on his experiences in the African and European campaigns.

Sgt. Kiss, a former bombardier, now a gunner on a Flying Fortress, has been awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received in action and the Oak Leaf Cluster for meritorious service in 37 sorties over enemy territory.

President Mitchell Schaeffer, a member of the policy and negotiation committees of the United Steelworkers of America, will give a report on wage negotiations between Bethlehem Steel Company and the union. Matters of importance will be discussed.

At the close of the meeting moving pictures of the war will be shown.
