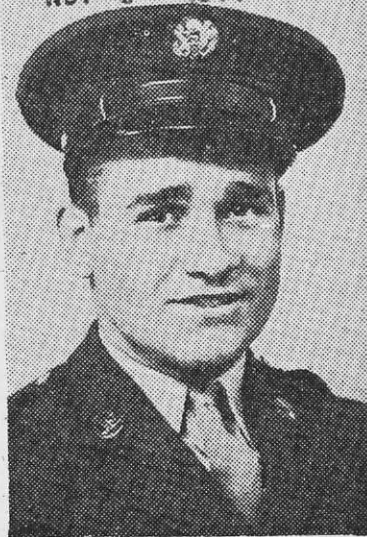


Achey, Mark P.

Wounded

Staff Sergeant Mark P. Achey, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harvey Achey, 29 East North Street, was wounded in action in Germany, October 18. The parents received this information in a War Department telegram sent them a few hours after they received the Purple Heart awarded to their son for wounds received August 14 in France.

S-Sgt. Achey was inducted March 12, 1940, while employed by the Sun Ship Yards. He received his training at camps in Louisiana, Kentucky, and graduated from gunnery school at Fort Knox. He has been overseas since September 3, 1943.

Two brothers are serving in the U. S. Navy. Richard L. is somewhere at sea and Warren T. has received his active duty assignment from an undisclosed port.
