An official telegram received from the War Department by Mr. and Mrs. Alexander Kercsmar, 639 Williams Street informed them that their son, Pvt. William Kercsmar, resumde actvie duty in the invasion of France July 26.

He had been wounded in action in the early days of the invasion and just recently had been discharged from a British hospital. Pvt. Kercsmar was inducted into the service on September 13, 1943, and received his basic training at Camp-Van Dorn, Mississippi. Since March of 1944, he had been stationed in England.

Pvt. Kercsmar is also the recipient of the Purple Heart for wounds sustained in line of duty in northern France.
