PFC. STANLEY WERKHEISER Pfc. S. Werkheiser, Nazareth, Killed **In German Action**

Pfc. Stanley R. Werkheiser, 203 East Center Street, Nazareth, was killed in action February 21 in Germany, according to a War Depart-ment telegram received by his wife. He had previously been reported missing on that date.

Pfc. Werkheiser entered the Army on January 11, 1944, and was stationed at Camp Croft, S. C., Camp Shelby, Miss., and Camp Meade, Md., before being sent over-seas last July.

He had been wounded on Sep-tember 10 in Metz, France, and had spent several months in hos-pitals recovering from the shrapnel wound in his arm. He was award-ed the Purple Heart at that time. In January he received the Expert Infantryman's Combat Badge. Prior to entering the service, he was employed by the Lone Star Cement Company, Nazareth.
