**Albert M. Zoltan, S1/C,
Witnessed Surrender
Of Japs on Pagan Island**

Albert M. Zoltan, 26, Seaman 1/C, from 709 East Fifth Street, witnessed the surrender of the Japanese garrison on Pagan Island from the destroyer USS Trippe in Apan Bay.

SEP 25 1945
Zoltan and crew members saw Commodore Vernon B. Grant, USN, accept the surrender from Maj. Gen. Umachachi Amau, island commander, on his flagship nearby. The ship, veteran of action in the Atlantic and Mediterranean, was part of the escort for the vessel which carried President Roosevelt to the Cairo conference in 1943.
