During Japan Invasion**

Mrs. J. H. Meyers, 625 Seventh Avenue, received a letter from her son, Capt. John P. Meyers, stating that he took part in the invasion of Japan, having led the second wave of 165 C-54 transports into Japan. There were 200 in all, carrying airborne infantry troops and American Military Government personnel.

Captain Meyers also stated that he helped evacuate prisoners of war. He is stationed with the Air Transport Command in Hamilton Field, California. SEP 27 1945
