Lt. (jg) Ray E. Scholl, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward H. Scholl, of Lahaska, Pa., a graduate of Moravian College and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, is one of the officers aboard the USS Missouri, on which the Japs will sign surrender terms. He left the employ of the Bethlehem Steel Company in 1943 to accept a commission as Ensign. He spent four months at Cornell University, two months at the Norfolk Naval Base and three months at Newport, R. I., Naval Base. He was advanced to Lieutenant last December.
