

Blake, Charles H.

Mrs. Charles H. Blake of 311 North Main Street, Bangor, has been notified by the United States War Department that her late husband, Master Sergeant Charles H. Blake of the United States Army has been posthumously awarded the American Defense Service Ribbon, the African Middle East Campaign Ribbon and two Bronze Stars.

Master Sgt. Blake, a member of the regular United States Army for more than 15 years was with the original American Expeditionary Forces that landed in North Africa under General Dwight D. Eisenhower. He also served under General George S. "Blood and Guts" Patton of the United States Seventh Army and was killed on April 3, 1943 at the Battle of El Ghattar, Tunisia. APR 26 1944
