Slightly Wounded**

Pvt. Leon C. Bartholomew, Bath, was reported "slightly wounded" on Luzon February 1, in a telegram received by his sister, Mrs. Roy H. Rohr, Bath, from the War Department at Washington.

Pvt. Bartholomew, husband of Nan (Leigh) Bartholomew, Allentown, was inducted into the service Christmas, 1943, and received his basic training at Fort Bragg, N. C. He saw service in North Africa, New Guinea and later in the Philippines.

He is a son of the late Clinton and Hannah Bartholomew, Bath.
