The second Purple Heart to
be awarded sons of the family
was received yesterday at the

wounded while serving with the

letter accompanying the medal
was the first information they
had received of their son's
wounds. He still is at an unidentified place in the South
Pacific. He is one of four serving the nation.
Sgt. Belcak enlisted in the
Marine Corps October 5, 1942,
and trained at Parris Island
and New River, N. C. He left
for the Pacific from Camp
Pendleton, Calif.
The other three sons in the
service are Pfc. Michael, wound-
