Corporal Walter Fluck, 503 Pawnee Street, completed a 27-day delay-enroute furlough and has arrived at Camp Butner, N. C., for reassignment. **JAN 10 1945**

Cpl. Fluck enlisted in the U. S. Army June 3, 1941, and was stationed on Oahu, one of the Hawaiian Islands, when the Japs struck at Pearl Harbor. He was then sent to the Fiji Islands, Guadalcanal and Bougainville. While serving overseas for three years and four months, Fluck was awarded the Good Conduct medal.

A brother, Seaman Second Class Roy Fluck, is somewhere in the Pacific where his brother-in-law, Fred Smith, is also serving with the Seabees.
