Area Youths Sent To Navigation School

SAN MARCOS, Tex.--Forty-seven Pennsylvanians have reported to the Army Air Forces Navigation School here for an 18 weeks' course in advanced aerial navigation at this AAF Training Command base.

They will receive intensive instruction in the four methods of navigation: Pilotage, dead reckoning, radio and celestial, and fly more than 15,000 miles to put into practice lessons learned in classrooms. Upon graduating, cadet members of the class will receive the silver wings of the AAF navigator and commissions as second lieutenants or appointments as flight officers. Student officers will receive their wings.
