Cpl. Charles Fuls, Bangor, Reported Killed In Germany

Word was received yesterday afternoon by Mrs. Mae Couch Fuls, of Northampton Street, Bangor, that her husband, Cpl. Charles Fuls, was killed in action in Germany on April 11.

Cpl. Fuls was inducted into the armed forces in August, 1944, and trained at Camp Van Dorn, Miss. He was sent overseas in November, 1944. Prior to his induction into the armed forces he was employed in the Belvidere, N. J., plant of the Hercules Powder Company.

The 29-year-old soldier is also survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Fuls, Bangor R. D. 1, and two brothers.
