Mrs. Paul B. Binder, 807 West Broad Street, yesterday received the Purple Heart posthumously awarded to her husband, Paul B. Binder, chief pharmacist Mate, U. S. Naval Reserve, who died on July 23 of wounds received in the invasion of Guam.

Accompanying the award was a citation signed by Secretary of the Navy Forrestal and Roland Jacobs, Vice Admiral, U. S. Navy, Chief of Navy Personnel, which read "for military merit and wounds received in action."
