

Bower, Dr. William T.

Ex-St. Luke's Interne Dies In Germany

Mrs. William T. Bower, physical therapist at St. Luke's Hospital since 1940, yesterday received a wire from the War Department informing her that her husband, Dr. William T. Bower, died April 21 in Germany from injuries received in a vehicle accident.

Dr. Bower, a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, completed a one-year internship at St. Luke's Hospital on July 1, 1942. He was immediately inducted into the armed forces with the Medical Gas Division and left for overseas duty in October, 1943. He served in England, France and Belgium, participating in D-Day operations with the rank of captain. His parents are residents of Philipsburg, Pa.

Captain and Mrs. Bower were married in Bethlehem, April 30, 1943. Mrs. Bower is the former Ruth Shultz, daughter of Rev. and Mrs. W. K. Shultz, of Steelton, Pa. On the receipt of the War Department telegram, she left yesterday for Steelton.
